‘During Psychology we had to match the phobia to what it means, for example Alektorophobia is the fear of chickens!’

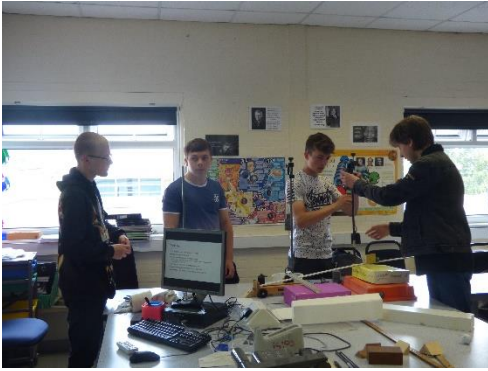


‘In Criminology we learned about people who commit crimes, profiling and about witness statements. It was really intriguing and enjoyable.’

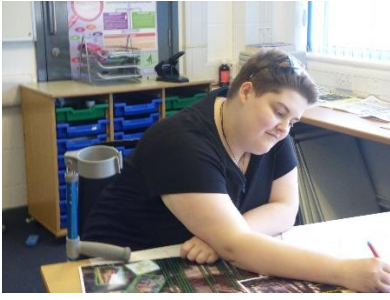
