

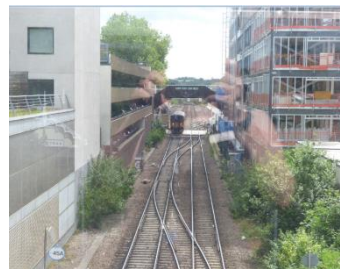
University of Lincoln Y10 Taster Day 2nd July 2019

All of Year 10 went to the University of Lincoln to sample what life might be like attending a large University in the centre of a city.

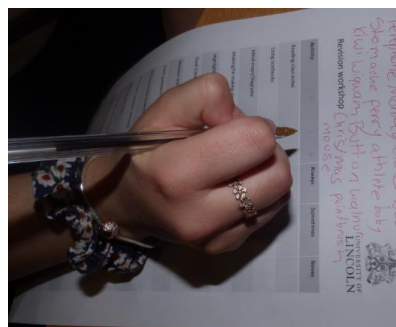
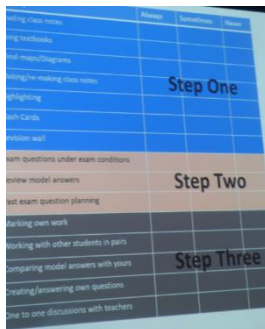
We began the morning with a tour of the campus looking at the various lecture areas and faculties, along with the accommodation.
