Sessions included the following:

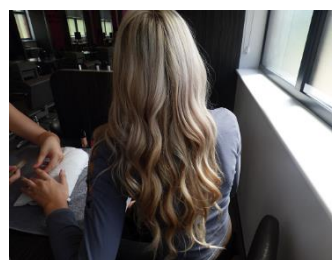
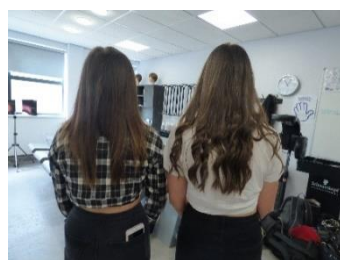
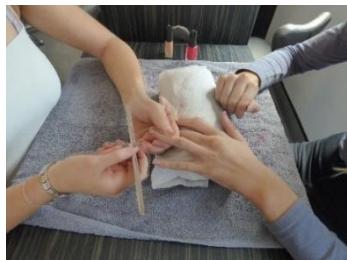

In the Engineering workshops, students worked in a variety of areas to spray paint, weld materials or build walls in Construction:

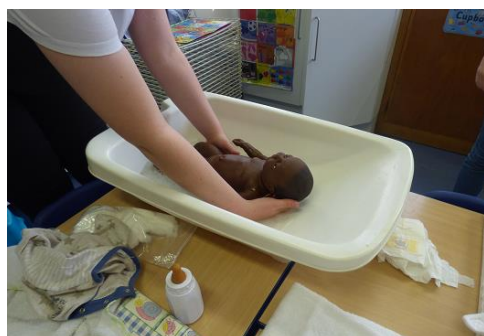


Lunch in the canteen was a time to relax and sample the food!
