Dear Parents / Carers,

As many of you will be aware from the news media, the NEU (National Education Union) have decided to take industrial action on Tuesday  $28^{th}$  February. This is the second of the four planned dates, the other two being the  $15^{th}$  and  $16^{th}$  March.

Following the experience of the first day of strike action on 1<sup>st</sup> February, we have more information to enable us to assess the potential impact that this strike day will have. To operate safely, we will need to operate another partial closure.

We will be open as normal to students in year 11 and 7 and to students who are vulnerable. Students will be expected to attend school in full uniform. For year 11 the planned educational activities for the day will focus on raising attainment in core subjects and completing important vocational coursework, another valuable day for ALL year 11 students. Year 7 students will be following their normal timetable.

For clarity, we will be closed to students in years 8 to 10. Students in these years who are classified as vulnerable will be contacted separately by the school with further information.

Years 8 - 10 will remain at home and receive work via Microsoft Teams. If your child requires support with logging on to Teams, please ensure they have spoken to their Year Leader prior to Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February.

Apologies for the reminder but it is important to note that the dispute is between the NEU and the government, not the school and as such we cannot do anything as a school to stop this action from taking place.
