Year 8 Parents' Evening

- Log in with your details and the details of your child
- Click on the date of the Parents' Evening
- Follow the on-screen instructions
- Select teachers and times
- Click 'generate appointments' at the bottom

When you have finished making your appointments, you will receive a confirmation email. It is important that we have an up-to-date and accurate email address to send the confirmation to. If you have changed your email address recently, please email reception@huntcliffschool.co.uk at the earliest opportunity.

The booking system will be open to make appointments from now until 12 midday on Wednesday 24th May 2023. For pupils whose parents do not reside together, please be aware that there can only be one meeting per subject so the meeting must be taken by one parent or with both parents present. Parents cannot make separate appointments for the same subject. **We advise that you leave 5 minutes 'travel time' between your appointments.**

If you do make an appointment and are not able to attend, please cancel the appointment so that others can book in your place. If there are no available appointment times to suit you, please contact the relevant teacher via school email and we will arrange a separate time to report upon the progress of your child.
